

SUMMER STAFF

- **Where:** Life Teen Camp Covecrest (Tiger, GA), Life Teen Camp Hidden Lake (Dahlonega, GA), or Life Teen Camp Wild Sky (Medina, TX).
- **Who:** Work with a team of 25-30 people as a part of Summer Staff at a Life Teen Summer Camp in Georgia or work with a team of 12-18 people to fill the role of Summer Staff at Life Teen Camp in Texas. Summer Staff journey alongside teens to help ensure the camp creates an environment that facilitates a relationship with Christ.
- **Community / Housing:** Summer Staff will attend formation sessions and will report to their Summer Staff Coordinator and Summer Staff Mentor for tasks and responsibilities. This person will also be housed with other Summer Staff members of the same gender.
- **Key Responsibilities:** Summer Staff answer Christ's call to build up His Kingdom on earth by leading middle and/or high school teens closer to Christ through service, relationship, and prayer. The primary role is to serve as a relational minister trained in the facilitation of small group discussions and team-building activities. Additionally, Summer Staff, like all Summer Missionaries, will be responsible for assisting in fundraising efforts for Life Teen to further the mission of leading teens closer to Christ. The main tasks for Summer Staff each week include:
 - Being assigned to and serving a parish each camp week from the time of the arrival to the time of their departure:
 - Partnering with the youth minister and core members to support the camp experience for the teens in the assigned parish group;
 - Participating in all scheduled camp programming and activities each camp week;
 - Helping to serve meals, assist prayer opportunities, and facilitate various camp activities, including an obstacle course, messy games, and high and low ropes elements;
 - Participating in mission community through living a structured and sacramental prayer life, supporting one another in common mission, and holding each other accountable.

- **Success Factors:** A successful Summer Staff team member will be relational and hospitable in journeying with teens each camp week. Summer Staff will be trained in the Life Teen model of ministry upon arrival to camp and must be able to successfully practice relational ministry and facilitate small groups. Serving as a part of Summer Staff requires a servant's heart with the ability to work collaboratively as a team. This prayerful, mission-minded, and obedient team member will be motivated to serve humbly however needed, saying "yes" to whatever tasks he or she is asked to do, and serving with joy while working long camp days.
- **Physical Demands:** This role requires extensive daily movement around camp property and frequent participation in physically demanding activities, such as rafting, climbing, and messy games. The role involves extensive work outdoors and moderate lifting up to 50 pounds.
